RESOLUTION NO. 16-773

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF HUMBLE, TEXAS, AMENDING SECTION 10.04 "MEDICAL INSURANCE" OF THE CITY OF HUMBLE PERSONNEL POLICIES.

WHEREAS, the governing body of the City of Humble, Texas deems it a necessity to amend Section 10.04 "Medical Insurance" of the Personnel Policies of the City of Humble by striking the text of section 10.04 in its entirety and replacing said section with the following:

10.05 **MEDICAL INSURANCE:** The City offers all regular full-time employees comprehensive medical insurance at no cost to the employee. Full-time employees may purchase medical insurance for their spouse and/or qualified dependents. The City may pay a portion of the monthly premium for spouse/dependent insurance and shall deduct the employee's portion in equal payments from their paychecks. The employee is responsible for informing Human Resources/Benefits of changes in the employee's spouse/dependent status such as getting married or divorced, giving birth to a child, adopting a child, etc. Failure to inform Human Resources/Benefits of these changes may change the insurability status of the spouse/dependents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HUMBLE TEXAS:

Section 1: That the City Council of the City of Humble, Texas does hereby amend Section 10.04 of the Personnel Policies of the City of Humble as stated in the preamble of this Resolution.

Section 2: That this amended Section shall go into effect immediately on and from the date of passage of this Resolution.


