

ORDINANCE NO. 17-810

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HUMBLE, TEXAS, EXTENDING THE DISASTER DECLARATION ISSUED BY MAYORAL PROCLAMATION ON AUGUST 27, 2017 AND CONTINUED BY ORDINANCE 17-808 ON SEPTEMBER 3, 2017 IN RESPONSE TO HURRICANE HARVEY.

WHEREAS, on August 27, 2017, the Mayor of the City of Humble, Texas, (the "City") issued a mayoral proclamation declaring a state of disaster for the City, in response to the anticipated loss of life and damage to property threatened by conditions resulting from Hurricane Harvey, and

WHEREAS, on September 3, 2017, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. 17-808 continuing the declaration of disaster through September 14, 2017, in accordance with Section 414.108 of the Texas Government Code; and

WHEREAS, the City suffered widespread or severe damage, injury, or loss of property resulting from Hurricane Harvey; and

WHEREAS, the conditions necessitating such disaster declaration continue to exist; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to alleviate the suffering of people and to protect or rehabilitate property; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HUMBLE, TEXAS:

Section 1. The declaration of disaster, which was signed and executed by the Mayor on August 27, 2017, and continued by Ordinance 17-808 shall be renewed and continued through September 30, 2017, in accordance with Section 418.108 of the Texas Government Code.
