



Re: Increased Tax Revenue and Required Public Hearings

The Truth in Taxation rules mandate a governmental unit publish the proposed tax rate and also hold two public hearings on a tax revenue increase. If the proposed rate exceeds the rollback or effective tax rate, whichever is lower, the taxing unit's governing body must vote to place a proposal to adopt the rate on a future meeting agenda and record a vote. The dates of the public hearings must be stated and notices must be published. The proposed rate for 2013 is \$0.20, the same as 2012. This exceeds the effective rate, which has been established as \$0.19, therefore action is required. Notices will be posted and public hearings will be held on both October 2nd, 2013 and October 17th, 2013. Adoption of the tax rate will occur on October 21st, 2013.

I recommend that Council adopt the resolution proposing the tax revenue increase and hold the required public hearings in accordance with state law.

RESOLUTION NO. 13-727

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HUMBLE, TEXAS CALLING TWO PUBLIC HEARINGS TO CONSIDER A TAX INCREASE BY INCREASING THE TOTAL TAX REVENUE FROM PROPERTIES ON THE TAX ROLL EXCEEDING THE AMOUNT GENERATED THE PRECEEDING YEAR, AND FINDING AND DETERMING THE MEETING AT WHICH THIS RESOLUTION IS ADOPTED TO BE OPEN TO THE PUBLIC AS REQUIRED BY LAW.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Humble is considering the adoption of a tax rate to fund the Fiscal Year 2013-2014 Budget; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 26, Texas Tax Code, requires that taxing jurisdictions conduct two public hearings if the taxing jurisdiction is considering a proposal to increase total tax revenues from properties on the tax roll that exceeds the total tax reveunes generated the previous year; and

WHEREAS, The Humble City Council wishes to consider increasing total tax revenue over the amount generated the previous year; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HUMBLE, TEXAS:

PART 1: That the City Council of the City of Humble, Texas does hereby call two (2) public hearings to be conducted on October 2, 2013 at 9:00 A.M. and October 17, 2013 at 6:00 P.M. in the City of Humble Council Chamber, 114 W. Higgins, Humble, Texas 77338. The purpose of which is to consider a tax rate that, if adopted, would increase revenue generated the previous year.

PART 2: That the City Council does hereby instruct the City Secretary to publish notice of such public hearings to be given in a manner complying with the requirements of Chapter 26, Texas Tax Code.

PART 3: That it is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this Resolution is passed is open to the public and that public notice of the time, place, location, and purpose of said meeting was given as required by law.

PART 4: That a recorded vote of the City Council will be taken determining the disposition of this Resolution and published in the Public Notice as required by law.
