


Mayor Aaron called the regular meeting of the Humble City Council to order with a quorum present at 6:30 P.M.

Council Member Funderburk offered the invocation and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Upon a motion by Council Member Funderburk, the City Council voted six (6) for and none (0) opposed to approve the Consent Agenda.

3. PRESENTATION ESTABLISH A COMMUNITY COVENANT BETWEEN THE UNITED STATES ARMY AND CITY OF HUMBLE.

Mayor Aaron welcomed members of the United States Army and introduced Captain Jose Real of the Houston Recruiting Command. Capt. Real thanked the city for joining the Army to sign a Community Covenant which seeks to formalize support and improve the quality of lives for soldiers in our community and strengthen the community's relationship with the Army. Capt. Real then invited Lt. Col. Jeff McCartney to say a few words. Lt. Col. McCartney thanked all veterans in attendance for their service and invited the City Council to sign the Community Covenant.

Following the signing ceremony, Capt. Real administered the Oath of Enlistment to several incoming Army Recruits.

Mayor Aaron thanked all for their service to their country and wanted to ensure that Capt. Real and the Houston Recruiting Command keep in contact with the City.

4. EXECUTIVE SESSION HELD IN THE CITY COUNCIL CONFERENCE ROOM; LEGAL ADVICE {GOV'T CODE SECTION 551.071} AND DELIBERATION OF PERSONNEL MATTERS {GOV'T CODE SECTION 551.074}; POSSIBLE ACTION

The City Council recessed the regular meeting to convene in Executive Session at 6:44 P.M. on Thursday, June 23, 2016.

The City Council reconvened the regular meeting at 7:35 P.M., no action was taken.

5. APPOINTMENT AND APPROVAL OF ASSISTANT CITY MANAGERS.

City Manager Boeske asked for approval of Aimee Phillips and Jason Stuebe to be named Assistant City Managers.

Upon a motion by Mayor Aaron, the City Council voted six (6) for and none (0) opposed to approve the appointment of Ms. Phillips and Mr. Stuebe as Assistant City Managers.

6. RESOLUTION 16-766 CREATING SECTION 4.22 "SOCIAL MEDIA POLICY" OF THE CITY OF HUMBLE PERSONNEL POLICIES.

City Manager Boeske asked for approval of the policy.

Upon a motion by Council Member Curry, the City Council voted six (6) for and none (0) opposed to approve Resolution 16-766 creating Section 4.22 of the Personnel Policies.

7. RESOLUTION 16-767 AMENDING SECTION 6.08 "LEAVE OFR ABSENCE – PERSONAL BUSINESS LEAVE OR EXTENDED LEAVES DUE TO PENDING INVESTIGATION" OF THE CITY OF HUMBLE PERSONNEL POLICIES.

City Manager Boeske asked for approval of the policy amendment.

Mayor Aaron noted that the city has identified several housekeeping measures that need to be addressed within the personnel policies and that the city will continue to update and improve them.

Upon a motion by Council Member Funderburk, the City Council voted six (6) for and none (0) opposed to approve Resolution 16-767 amending Section 6.08 of the Personnel Policies.

8. APPROVAL OF THE TOWNSEN BOULEVARD STREET DEDICATION NO. 1 PLAT BEING A SUBDIVISION OF 15.256 ACRES OF LAND SITUATED IN THE T.F. PINKNEY SURVEY, ABSTRACT NO. 1588, CITY OF HUMBLE, HARRIS COUNTY, TEXAS; 0 LOTS, 2 BLOCKS, 4 RESERVES.

City Manager Boeske asked for conditional approval of the plat.

Mayor Aaron stated that the city had some conditions that will be addressed by city staff and representatives from the developers prior to final approval and recordation.

City Manager Boeske stated that while the roadway meets our drainage requirements, the City requests that the developer takes every measure they can to ensure that the impact on flood threats is mitigated.

Upon a motion by Council Member Steagall, the City Council voted six (6) for and none (0) opposed to conditionally approve the Development Plat for the Townsen Boulevard Street Dedication No. 1 Plat.

The Texas Supreme Court Reverses Itself in Flooding Case

The Texas Supreme Court, in a rare move, reversed itself last week and issued a new opinion in [*Harris County Flood Control District v. Kerr*](#). The case began when over 400 landowners and former landowners whose properties were damaged by flooding sued Harris County, making inverse condemnation (taking) and nuisance claims. They argued that Harris County and the Harris County Flood Control District (Harris County) approved new upstream development without implementing appropriate flood-control measures, and did so even though they were substantially certain that flooding of the properties would result.

Harris County argued that there were no facts supporting the landowners' claims that it intended to flood their properties. ("Intent" to cause the taking is a required element for such a claim.) Both the trial and court of appeals disagreed. Harris County appealed, asking the Texas Supreme Court to consider whether or not the homeowners raised a fact question regarding the elements of a governmental taking.

The Texas Supreme Court issued its initial opinion on June 12, 2015, holding in a 5-4 decision that the homeowners had raised a fact issue by presenting evidence demonstrating that: (1) Harris County knew unmitigated development would lead to flooding; (2) Harris County approved development without appropriately mitigating it; and (3) the approval caused the flooding. Despite the majority's assurance that "We do not decide the merits of the dispute, nor do we mean to imply that the government entities have a duty to prevent all flooding," the opinion caused a wave of controversy and concern among counties and cities.

Harris County sought and the Court granted a rehearing on February 19. More than a dozen amicus (“friends of the court”) briefs, including one by the Conference of Urban Counties, Texas Association of Counties, and TML, were filed in conjunction with the motion for rehearing.

On June 17, the Court withdrew its original opinion and issued a substitute opinion. In an important win for cities, counties and other entities across the state, the Court dismissed the plaintiffs’ lawsuit, holding that Harris County was not responsible for damages suffered from the flooding. “[T]he record is clear that the County never harbored a desire to cause flooding anywhere. Its motive was the opposite: it desired to prevent flooding and undertook extensive efforts over many years to accomplish this goal,” the Court stated. The Court also agreed with arguments that, if the lawsuit was successful, it would significantly extend takings liability and “encourage governments to do nothing to prevent flooding [and other problems], instead of studying and addressing the problem.”

General Law Cities: **Grass-Roots Support Needed to Clarify Authority over Sex** **Offender Residency**

A number of legal challenges to the authority of general law cities to regulate where sex offenders can live are moving through the courts. But general law cities that wish to clarify their authority should act now to pave the way for legislative action next session. State Representative Drew Springer (R – Muenster) has asked interested general law cities to adopt a resolution in support of legislation to clarify their authority. (Any city adopting such a resolution should send it to Monty Wynn at monty@tml.org in the League’s legislative department for delivery to Rep. Springer’s office.)

For example, the City of Eustace adopted a [resolution](#) doing just that. In the meantime, the issue of legislative clarification will be considered by the TML Legislative Policy Committee on General Government in Austin on August 19. It is expected that the League’s current position to “support legislation that would clarify the authority of general law cities to enact sex offender residency restrictions” will be re-adopted for 2017.

The League will provide continued updates on the lawsuits and legislative efforts.

Payday Lending Clearinghouse Updates

The League’s “Payday Lending Clearinghouse” webpage, available at www.tml.org/payday-updates, includes information related to the regulation of payday and auto title lenders. It is updated from time-to-time to reflect recent developments. Interested city officials should note that, on June 16, the Texas Supreme Court denied a petition for review filed by ACE Cash Express. The denial essentially ends ACE’s lawsuit against the City of Denton, and does so in the city’s favor.

Oil and Gas Regulation Clearinghouse

As reported last December, the first post-H.B. 40 lawsuit was filed against the City of Rockdale. On June 13, a federal district court found in favor of the city and dismissed the case. To assist cities dealing with oil and gas drilling issues, the League has created the “Oil and Gas Regulation” webpage at www.tml.org (Go to the Legal tab and click on the Topics drop down menu). The page contains more information about the case, and the actual court order.

Resolutions for the 2016 TML Annual Conference

The TML Constitution states that resolutions for consideration at the Annual Conference must be submitted to the TML headquarters 45 calendar days prior to the first day of the Annual Conference. For 2016, this provision means that resolutions from any member city, TML region, or TML affiliate must arrive at the TML headquarters no later than 5:00 p.m. on **August 22, 2016**.

The TML Board of Directors has adopted several procedures governing the resolutions process. Please review the following items carefully and thoroughly.

1. No resolution may be considered by the TML Resolutions Committee unless it has prior approval of: (a) the governing body of a TML member city; (b) the governing body or membership of a TML affiliate, or (c) the membership of a TML region at a regional meeting.
2. TML member cities, regions, and affiliates that wish to submit a resolution **must** complete a resolution cover sheet. The cover sheet is available here. The [cover sheet](#) must be attached to the resolution throughout each step of the resolutions process.
3. It is recommended that any resolution state one of four categories to better direct League staff. Those categories are:
 - **Seek Introduction and Passage** means that the League will attempt to find a sponsor, will provide testimony, and will otherwise actively pursue passage. Bills in this category are known as “TML bills.”
 - **Support** means the League will attempt to obtain passage of the initiative if it is introduced by a city or some other entity.
 - **Oppose**.
 - **Take No Position**.

4. Resolutions submitted will be thoroughly discussed at the TML Annual Conference. The Resolutions Committee is appointed by the TML President and is made up of city officials from TML member cities across the state.
5. The city, region, or affiliate that submits a resolution is encouraged to send a representative to the Resolutions Committee meeting to explain the resolution. The Resolutions Committee will meet at **2:00 p.m.** on **Tuesday, October 4, 2016**, at the **Austin Convention Center**.

If the procedures described above are not followed for any given resolution, that resolution is likely to be referred to some other TML committee for further study. In that case, the resolution would not be adopted during the 2016 conference.

Under the TML Constitution, resolutions received after the deadline of August 22, 2016, must not only have the attached cover sheet, but also must “state the reason precluding timely submission.” These late resolutions may be considered by the TML Resolutions Committee at the Annual Conference only if two-thirds of the Committee members present and voting agree to suspend the submission rule and consider the resolution.

Cities in the PUC's Crosshairs

The Texas Public Utility Commission is the state agency that regulates private utility providers. Every so often, however, the Commission seeks to expand its authority to include cities.

For example, the Commission sought input on whether it could completely eliminate telecommunications franchise fees in 2009. Of course, it doesn't have the statutory authority to do so. Since that time, only a handful of instances have required intervention to preserve municipal authority.

Fast-forward to this year, and it appears that a number of private utility providers, including telecommunications, water, and electric, are using the Commission to seek to chip away at municipal authority. The League has filed briefs in *five* proceedings in the last six months that seek to usurp municipal authority:

1. **Right-of-Way Fees:** *Public Utilities Commission Docket No. 45280, Complaint of Exenet Network Sys., Inc. against the City of Houston for imposition of fees for use of public right-of-way.* In this proceeding, a certificated telecommunications provider is asking the Commission to allow it to place wireless telecommunications equipment in a city's rights-of-way by right and without paying compensation to the city. The brief in support of the City of Houston was filed on February 17, 2016.
2. **Water Rate Jurisdiction:** *Appeal of Water and Sewer Rates Charged by the Town of Woodloch Nos. 12312 and 20141, PUC Docket No. 42862.* In this proceeding, the Commission asserted jurisdiction over the *in-city* rates of a municipally owned water utility. The League filed comments in support of the City of Woodloch on April 25, 2016, and also filed reply comments on May 5, 2016.

3. **Certificates of Convenience and Necessity:** *Application of the City of Cibolo for Single Certification in an Incorporated Area and to Decertify Portions of Green Valley SUD's Sewer Certificate of Convenience and Necessity in Guadalupe County*, PUC Docket No. 45702. In this proceeding, a special utility district argues that federal debt in connection with its *sewer* certificate of convenience and necessity is enough to prohibit a city from decertifying a portion of the city's *water* CCN under state law. The League filed comments in support of the City of Cibolo on June 14, 2016.
4. **Municipal Subdivision Ordinance/Electric Undergrounding:** *Appeal of CenterPoint Energy Houston Electric, LLC from an Ordinance of the City of League City, Texas and Application for Declaratory Relief*, PUC Docket No. 45259. In this docket, CenterPoint Energy claims that a city may not, through its subdivision ordinance, require a developer to request undergrounded distribution lines pursuant to a city's subdivision ordinance. The League filed a letter in support of League City on June 29, 2016.
5. **Municipal Zoning/PUC Jurisdiction:** *Appeal of Brazos Electric Cooperative, Inc. and Denton County Electric Cooperative, Inc. D/B/A CoServ Electric from an Ordinance of The Colony, Texas, and, in the alternative, Application for a Declaratory Order*, PUC Docket No. 45175. In this docket, electric cooperatives appeal a city's denial of a specific use permit for an electric substation and claim that the Commission has jurisdiction to overturn the city's zoning ordinance. The League filed comments in support of the City of The Colony on July 8, 2016.

Standing alone, each of the Commission proceedings above could have a serious impact on cities. Altogether, they could be devastating. League staff will continue to monitor and participate as necessary.

Attorney General Opinion: **Cities Can't Prohibit Licensed Carry in Executive Session**

On June 27, the attorney general issued [Opinion No. KP-0098](#). The League contends that the opinion confuses the meaning of the term "open meeting" in a way that would mistakenly permit the carrying of handguns into executive sessions, even in cases where they are prohibited in the main meeting. The request for the opinion asked multiple questions concerning the requirements a city must follow when "posting notice about the carrying of handguns at open and closed meetings of a city council."

Legislation passed in 2015 prohibits licensed carry "in the room or rooms where a meeting of a governmental entity is held and if the meeting is an open meeting subject to [the Open Meetings Act] and the entity provided notice..."

Sections 30.06 and 30.07 of the Penal Code provide the language to be used in a notice to prohibit entry with a concealed handgun and entry with a handgun that is carried openly. The

request was meant to clarify where the signs should be posted. That clarification was sought because Section 30.06 states that the concealed carry prohibition sign should be “displayed in a conspicuous manner clearly visible to the public.” Section 30.07, for some inexplicable reason, has additional language stating that the open carry prohibition sign should be “displayed in a conspicuous manner clearly visible to the public *at each entrance to the property.*”

The confusion came from the fact that a city can’t generally prohibit open carry in city facilities, so it wouldn’t make sense to post that sign “at each entrance to the property.” Most attorneys had simply advised that a city wanting to prohibit carry in the meeting room do so by temporarily posting the signs at the entrance to the room when a meeting is taking place. The opinion essentially agreed, but it also included an analysis related to “closed meetings.”

The 2015 legislation prohibiting licensed carry “in the room or rooms where a meeting of a governmental entity is held and if the meeting is an *open meeting*” was added to clarify that only meetings of bodies governed by the Open Meetings Act are off limits, and only then if a city posts signage. The phrase “open meeting” in that statute clearly means one that is subject to the Open Meetings Act. However, the attorney general office reads it literally to not include a “closed meeting (i.e., an executive session).” In other words, the opinion concludes that a city can’t prohibit a person from licensed carrying into an executive session.

Of course, only members of the governing body have an absolute right to be in an executive session anyway. And a city can prohibit its employees from carrying at all while at work. But it’s conceivable that the governing body could invite some other person to attend an executive session. If that’s the case, the attorney general says the city can’t prohibit that citizen from licensed carrying in that meeting.

On July 5, the League submitted a letter requesting that the attorney general’s office reconsider the portion of the opinion related to executive sessions.

Lawsuit: Licensed Carry in Court Buildings

In the wake of [two confusing attorney general opinions](#) related to licensed handgun carry, court facilities, and signage, some local governments [called foul](#). The issue is whether the entire building that houses a court, or only the actual courtroom and court offices, is off-limits to licensed carriers. Waller County, located northwest of Houston, has filed a [lawsuit](#) to find out the answer.

Terry Holcomb is the leader of the group known as Open Carry Texas, and spends much of his time complaining about governmental entities posting licensed carry signage in what he alleges is the wrong place or with the wrong wording. He sent a written complaint to Waller County officials claiming that – based on a recently-issued [attorney general opinion](#) – they can’t prohibit licensed carry in the entire courthouse building. He also claims that the attorney general’s office, under its investigatory authority over signage, can seek civil penalties against the county if it refuses to remove its signs. (Another recently-issued [attorney general opinion](#) incorrectly asserts investigatory authority that is not authorized by law.)

The county filed a lawsuit against Mr. Holcomb seeking a declaratory judgment from a district court that: (1) the entire courthouse is off-limits to licensed carriers; and (2) the attorney general's office doesn't have as much enforcement authority as it claims. The ultimate answer from that court case should provide guidance to cities that house municipal courtrooms and court offices in multi-use city facilities.

Texas Voter ID Law Violates the Voting Rights Act

In the latest chapter in Texas' five-year long [voter ID saga](#), the federal Fifth Circuit Court of Appeals determined in [Marc Veasey Et Al v. Greg Abbott Et Al](#), a lengthy opinion that the law does, in fact, violate Section 2 of the Voting Rights Act. A majority of the Fifth Circuit's 15 judges held that the voter ID legislation has a "discriminatory effect."

Interestingly, the Court did not "strike down" the law. Instead, it remanded the case back to district court to "fix" the law's discriminatory effect. According to the opinion, "[i]t would be untenable to permit a law with a discriminatory effect to remain in operation for" the November 2016 election. Due to the fact that the November election is only a few months away, the Court recognized that a legislative fix in a special legislative session isn't feasible. As a result, the opinion expressly permits the district court to enter an order that remedies the discriminatory effect.

What will the district court's "fix" look like? The opinion provides that the district court must do so "while respecting the Legislature's stated objective to safeguard the integrity of elections by requiring more secure forms of voter identification." City election officials can therefore expect much of the current voter ID law to remain in place, albeit with some additional safeguards to protect previously disenfranchised voters. The opinion suggests that the district court could remedy the law by reinstating voter registration cards as acceptable identification, or potentially allowing for an indigence exception to the current voter ID requirement.

Committee to Consider Internet Posting of Legal Notices

Last session, the Texas Legislature passed a resolution creating the [Joint Interim Committee on Advertising Public Notices](#). On August 18, the committee will hear testimony related to “the use of technology in the posting and advertising to the public of legally required notices.” The meeting will be in the Capitol Extension, Room E1.030, at 1:00 p.m.

League staff has been invited to testify, and will advocate for the abandonment of the archaic and costly system of printed newspaper publication.

ORDINANCE NO. 16-782

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF HUMBLE, TEXAS READOPTING CITY OF HUMBLE ORDINANCE 13-719 WHICH ESTABLISHED A CURFEW FOR PERSONS UNDER THE AGE OF 17 YEARS, BETWEEN 11:00 P.M. ON SUNDAY, MONDAY, TUESDAY, WEDNESDAY, OR THURSDAY AND 6:00 A.M. ON THE FOLLOWING DAY, BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 12:01 A.M. AND 6:00 A.M. ON ANY SATURDAY OR SUNDAY, AND BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 9:00 A.M. AND 2:30 P.M. FOR SCHOOL-AGED CHILDREN ON SCHOOL DAYS; PROVIDING IT UNLAWFUL FOR ANY PERSON SUBJECT TO A CURFEW HEREUNDER TO REMAIN IN ANY PUBLIC PLACE OR ON THE PREMISES OF ANY ESTABLISHMENT WITHIN THE CITY DURING CURFEW HOURS; PROVIDING IT UNLAWFUL FOR ANY PARENT OR GUARDIAN OF AP ERSON SUBJECT TO A CURFEW HEREUNDER TO KNOWINGLY PERMIT, OR BY INSUFFICIENT CONTROL, ALLOW SUCH PERSON TO REMAIN IN ANY PUBLIC PLACE OR ON THE PREMISES OF ANY ESTABLISHMENT WITHIN THE CITY DURING CURFEW HOURS; PROVIDING IT UNLAWFUL FOR ANY PERSON OWNING, OPERATING, OR IN THE EMPLOYMENT OF ANY ESTABLISHMENT IN THE CITY TO KNOWINGLY ALLOW A PERSON SUBJECT TO A CURFEW HEREUNDER TO REMAIN ON THE PREMISES OF SUCH ESTABLISHMENT DURING CURFEW HOURS; PROVIDING DEFENSES TO PROSECUTION FOR VIOLATIONS HEREUNDER; PROVIDING A PENALTY OF AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$500.00 FOR EACH DAY OF VIOLATION OF ANY PROVISION HEREOF; MAKING CERTAIN FINDINGS; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES INCONSISTENT OR IN CONFLICT HERewith AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY. IT IS THE INTENTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED THAT THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BECOME AND BE MADE PART OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, CITY OF HUMBLE, TEXAS AND THE SECTIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE MAY BE RENUMBERED TO ACCOMPLISH SUCH INTENTION.

WHEREAS, public hearings were conducted on July 28, 2016 and August 11, 2016 to consider an extension of the juvenile curfew ordinance for a term of three years and it was the opinion of the City Council to extend the ordinance for three years as the City Council has determined that the curfew ordinance has had a positive effect as a deterrent to juvenile violence, juvenile gang activity, and crime committed by persons under the age of 17 years in the City of Humble, Texas; and

WHEREAS, due to their lack of maturity and experience, persons under the age of 17 years are particularly susceptible to participate in unlawful and gang-related activities and to be victims of older perpetrators of crime; and

WHEREAS, the City of Humble has an obligation to provide for the protection of minors from each other and from other persons, for the enforcement of parental control over the responsibility for children, for the protection of the general public and for the reduction of the incidence of juvenile violence and criminal activity; and

WHEREAS, a curfew applicable to persons under the age of 17 years will be in the interest of public health, safety and general welfare and will diminish the undesirable impact of such conduct on the citizens of the City of Humble;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HUMBLE, TEXAS, THAT:

Section 1. The facts and matters set forth in the preamble of this Ordinance are hereby found to be true and correct.

Section 2. Purpose. It is the express purpose of this ordinance to (a) deter criminal conduct involving juveniles, (b) reduce the number of juvenile crime victims, (c) reduce injury from accidents involving juveniles, (d) reduce the additional time police officers are required to be in the field due to juvenile crime, (e) provide additional and more effective means and options for dealing with gang-related violence and crime, (f) reduce juvenile peer pressure to stay out late, (g) reduce juvenile peer pressure to participate in violent or criminal activities and (h) assist parents in the control of their children.

Section 3. Definitions. For the purposes of this Ordinance the following words or terms shall have the meanings ascribed thereto:

(A) Curfew Hours shall mean:

- (1) 11:00 p.m. on any Sunday, Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, or Thursday until 6:00 a.m. of the following day;
- (2) 12:01 a.m. until 6:00 a.m. on any Saturday or Sunday; and
- (3) 9:00 a.m. until 2:30 p.m. on any Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday or Friday; provided, however, the hours defined in this paragraph (3) shall not be considered as Curfew Hours for minors not subject to compulsory school attendance pursuant to §21.032, Texas Education Code, nor shall the hours defined in this paragraph (3) be considered as Curfew Hours on days or during periods in which the school where the applicable minor is enrolled is closed or classes for which the applicable minor is enrolled have been canceled under the order and direction of officials authorized to issue such orders and directives.

- (B) Emergency shall mean any unforeseen combination of circumstances or the resulting state that calls for immediate action. This term shall include, but not be limited to, a fire, natural disaster, automobile accidents or any situation requiring immediate action to prevent serious bodily injury or loss of life.
- (C) Establishment shall mean any privately owned place of business operated for a profit to which the public is invited including, but not limited to, any place of amusement or entertainment.
- (D) Guardian shall mean a person who, under court order, is the guardian of the person of a minor or a public or private agency with whom a minor has been placed by a court.
- (E) Minor shall mean any person under 17 years of age.
- (F) Operator shall mean any individual, firm, association, partnership or corporation operating, managing or conducting any establishment. The term includes the members or partners of an association or partnership and the officers of a corporation.
- (G) Parent shall mean a person who is a natural parent, adoptive parents, stepparent of a minor, a responsible adult or a person at least 18 years of age who is authorized by the parent or guardian to have the care and custody of such minor.
- (H) Police Department shall mean the Humble Police Department or any successor police department of the City of Humble.
- (I) Public Place shall mean any place to which the public or a substantial group of the public has access and shall include but not be limited to, streets, highways and the common areas of schools, hospitals, apartment houses, office buildings, transport facilities, restaurants, theaters, game rooms, shops, shopping centers or any other place that offers for sale services or merchandise.
- (J) Remain shall mean to linger or stay or fail to leave premises when required to do so by a police officer or the owner, operator or other person in control of the premises.
- (K) Serious Bodily Injury shall mean bodily injury that creates a substantial risk of death or that causes death, serious permanent disfigurement or protracted loss or impairment of the function of any bodily member or organ.

Section 4 Offenses.

- (A) It shall be unlawful for any minor to knowingly remain, walk, run, stand or operate or ride about in any motor vehicle or bicycle in or upon any public place or on the premises of any establishment within the City during curfew hours.
- (B) It shall be unlawful for the parent or guardian of a minor to knowingly permit, or by insufficient control, allow a minor to remain in or upon any public place or on the premises of any establishment within the City during curfew hours.
- (C) It shall be unlawful for the owner, operator or any employee of an establishment to knowingly allow a minor to remain upon the premises of the establishment during curfew hours.

Section 5

Defenses.

- (A) It shall be a defense to prosecution under Section 4 of this Ordinance that the minor was:
 - (1) accompanied by the minor's parent or guardian;
 - (2) on an errand at the direction of the minor's parent or guardian;
 - (3) in a motor vehicle involved in interstate travel;
 - (4) engaged in lawful employment activity or going directly to the employment activity or returning directly to the minor's residence from the employment activity;
 - (5) involved in an emergency;
 - (6) on an errand made necessary by an illness, injury, or emergency;
 - (7) on the sidewalk abutting the minor's permanent residence or abutting the residence of a next door neighbor of the minor's permanent residence if the neighbor did not complain to the police department about the minor's presence thereon;
 - (8) attending a school, religious or government sponsored or other civic activity supervised by adults and sponsored by an educational, religious, or governmental institution, civic organization or other similar entity, or traveling directly to or returning from any such school, religious, governmental or civic activity.
 - (9) engaged, participating in or traveling to or from any event, function, or activity for which the application of Section 4 of this Ordinance would contravene the minor's rights protected by the United States Constitution including, but not limited to, First Amendment rights such as the free exercise of religion, freedom of speech or the right of assembly.
 - (10) married or had been married or had disabilities of minority removed in accordance with Chapter 31 of the Texas Family Code.

- (B) It is a defense to prosecution under Section 4(C) that the owner, operator or employee of an establishment promptly notified the police department that a minor was present on the premises of the establishment during curfew hours and the minor refused to leave.
- (C) It is a defense to prosecution under Section 4 of this Ordinance that the minor has been directed by his or her parent or guardian to engage in a specific activity or to carry out expressed instructions during the time that the minor is actually engaged in fulfilling those directions or responsibilities.

Section 6 Enforcement. Before taking any enforcement action under this Ordinance, a police officer shall ask the apparent offender's age and reason for being in the public place or establishment. The officer shall not issue a citation or make an arrest under this Ordinance unless the officer reasonably believes that an offense has occurred and that based on any response and other circumstances, no defense in Section 5 is present.

Section 7 Penalties.

- (A) A person who shall violate any provision of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, shall be fined in an amount not to exceed \$500.00. Each day of violation shall constitute a separate offense.
- (B) When required by Section 51.08 of the Texas Family Code as amended, the municipal court shall waive original jurisdiction over a minor who violates Section 4(A) of this Ordinance and shall refer the minor to juvenile court.

Section 8 All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent or in conflict herewith, are, to the extent of such inconsistency or conflict, hereby repealed.

Section 9 In the event any clause, phrase, provision, sentence or part of this Ordinance or the application of the same to any person or circumstance shall for any reason be adjudged invalid or held unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, it shall not affect, impair or invalidate this Ordinance as a whole or any part or provision hereof other than the part declared to be invalid or unconstitutional; and the City Council of the City of Humble, Texas declared that it would have passed each and every part of the same notwithstanding the omission of any such part thus declared to be invalid or unconstitutional, whether there be one or more parts.

Section 10 It is the intention of the City Council and it is hereby ordained, that the provisions of this Ordinance shall become and be made part of the Code of Ordinances, City of Humble, Texas and the sections of this Ordinance may be renumbered to accomplish such intention.

Section 11 The provisions of this Ordinance shall take effect from the adopting date by the City Council, and ten (10) days after the publication of the caption of

said Ordinance as the law in such cases provides, and it is accordingly so ordained.

INTRODUCED and CONSIDERED in an open meeting of the City Council of the City of Humble on the 11th day of August, 2016.

Dear Mr. Brock:

ARKK Engineers, LLC (ARKK) is pleased to submit this proposal for performing engineering services for the above referenced projects. This proposal is based on our understanding of the project as per our previous meetings and conversations. These projects include replacing the Rankin Road north roadside ditch outfalls into Garner's Bayou, improvements to the detention pond at the Civic Center, and improvements to the detention pond at the Southwest Wastewater Treatment Plant.

The Rankin Road outfall improvement project will replace the two roadside ditch outfalls on the north side of Rankin Road. The existing pipes are corrugated metal pipe which have rusted thru and are causing sinkholes along the road at the bridge. Garner's Bayou is a Harris County Flood Control District (HCFCD) maintained stream, therefore, this project will require HCFCD approval and will be designed according to the Harris County Flood Control District requirements.

The detention pond improvement project involves two (2) existing ponds. The first will consist of converting the detention pond at the Civic Center to a wet bottom pond, and repairing the eroded pond banks. The detention pond at the Civic Center makes water from the bottom of the pond which keeps the bottom to wet to adequately maintain. It is proposed to convert this detention pond into a wet pond which will always have water in it and eliminates the need to mow the bottom of the pond. The second detention pond is located at the City's SWWTP, and is experiencing erosion on the west slope due to the water standing on the property to the west of the pond. It is proposed to install backslope interceptor swales and pipes that would drain into the detention pond, and to reshape and reestablish the eroded west side pond bank.

SCOPE OF SERVICES

A. Design Phase Basic Services

- Research and gather existing data on the project such as existing utility information and As-Built drawings on the existing facilities.

- Plot survey data of the proposed Rankin storm sewer outfall alignment and evaluate potential alignment alternatives.
- Examine geotechnical information to determine potential soil conditions and potential impact on construction methodology and costs.
- Compile and review other existing information such as environmental assessments, right-of-way, easements, and traffic control requirements
- Provide estimated construction costs.
- Coordinate with the City of Humble and apprise the City of ARKK's findings and analysis, and obtain input from the City.
- Meet with the City at the 30% design completion phase. At the 30% design meeting, the following Items will be discussed:
 - Construction Cost Estimates.
 - Items which will affect the project cost and time during construction.
 - Information and coordination with other governmental and utility agencies, and data on any required permitting.
- Prepare final engineering design drawings and specifications as two separate projects, one for the Rankin Road outfall repair and one for the detention pond improvements portion of the project.
- Prepare final cost estimate for the project.
- Complete coordination with other governmental entities or utility agencies in regard to the project. Assist the City in obtaining and/or securing approvals required by all governmental authorities with jurisdiction over the design and/or the operation of the project and all public and private utilities including pipeline transmission companies affected by this project. This assistance will involve the usual expected coordination and approval process. When the process involves work beyond the expected, such as; special submittals, designs, appearances at special meetings, coordination of utility/pipeline excavation efforts, permitting applications, etc., such work would be considered under the Additional Services portion of this proposal.
- Coordinate with the City of Humble during the final design process and provide draft documents for the City to review and comment upon. Incorporate appropriate comments with the final bid documents.
- Furnish three (3) sets of construction documents to the City.

B. Special Design Phase Services for the Project

Surveying Services

- Obtain topographical survey for the right-of-way in the Rankin Road outfall project area. The survey shall locate right-of-way iron rods and property corners at periodic locations to aid in locating the right-of-way. A CAD file showing the apparent right-of-way line on the topographical survey will be provided based on the located right-of-way iron rods. Perform “measure downs” and provide vertical elevation information on the existing sanitary sewer, and other utilities in the project area.
- Topographic surveying will be performed on the two detention pond sites to the detail necessary for the design of the proposed pond improvements.
- This scope does not include survey services associated with easement documents or acquiring right of way.

Geotechnical Investigation Services

- Field Exploration: 2 borings are anticipated to be drilled to a combined depth of 40 feet at the Civic Center Detention Pond to evaluate subsurface conditions.
- Laboratory Testing - Soil mechanics laboratory testing will be performed to measure physical and engineering properties of selected representative soil samples.
- Geotechnical Report - The geotechnical report will provide recommendations and construction criteria for the project area.
- Traffic Control & Sequencing
- Prepare traffic control plans and construction sequencing and roadway marking plans for the Rankin Road outfall improvements.

C. Construction Phase Services

- This phase will be entered into after the acceptance of the final engineering design drawings and documents by the City of Humble.
- Assist the City in obtaining bids for the project. The City of Humble will advertise the projects and will absorb all related advertising costs. ARKK will coordinate with the City and will assist in developing the wording of the advertisement.
- ARKK will dispense bid documents to potential bidders and suppliers, using the Civcast online plan room service operated by Amtek USA. This will help to increase interest in the project from potential bidders and allow them to download the contract documents remotely.

- During the bidding process, provide information to and answer questions from potential bidders concerning the Project's construction documents and prepare addendums as necessary.
- Evaluate the bids and the qualifications of the apparent low bidders and advise the City as to the acceptability of the apparent low bidder.
- Act as the City's Project Representative during the construction phase.
- Review and respond accordingly to all submittals as required by the contract specifications.
- Prepare change orders necessitated by field conditions.
- Review the contractor's pay estimates, evaluate the completion of work, and make payment recommendations to the City.
- Visit the site at intervals appropriate to the various stages of construction to observe the progress and quality of executed work and to determine in general if such work is proceeding in accordance with the Contract Documents. Full time site representation is not included as part of this proposal.
- ARKK will not be responsible for the means, methods, techniques, sequences or procedures of construction selected by the Contractor(s) or the safety precautions and programs incident to the work of the Contractor(s). ARKK's effort will be directed toward providing a greater degree of confidence for the City of Humble that the completed work of Contractor(s) will conform to the Contract Documents, but ARKK will not be responsible for the failure of Contractor(s) to perform the work in accordance with the Contract Documents. During site visits ARKK shall keep the City informed of the progress of the work, shall endeavor to guard the City against defects and deficiencies in such work and may disapprove or reject work failing to conform to the Contract Documents.
- Conduct a final review of the Project and make a recommendation for Final Payment on the Project.
- Engineer shall provide one set of reproducible record plans based on the drawings provided to the Engineer by the Contractor(s).

D. **Additional Services**

Additional services are those services that are beyond the services provided for in the scope portion of this proposal.

Additional services may be required and may be identified as the project progresses. Such

services are to be performed only when authorized by the City. Potential Additional services include:

1. Right-of-way research, deed research, and abstracting.
2. Site Easement and Right of Way Acquisition work such as: preparation of metes and bounds; verification of ownership of property; preparation and submittal of title report or title commitment.
3. Environmental Site Assessments.
4. Extra Construction Phase Services in the event the project extends beyond its designated contract period.
5. Securing any special licenses, permits or approvals (railroad crossings, State permits or approvals, pipelines, etc.) which may be required for the completion of the project, it being understood by the parties of this agreement that the fees for said special licenses and permits will be paid by the City.
6. The provision of a construction site representative and associated supervision and administration services.
7. Coordination with utility pipeline field location efforts and special meetings with pipeline companies.

FEE

Mileage will be charged at \$0.55 per mile. No additional services will be performed or invoiced without prior authorization from the City of Humble.

1. Instruments of Service - All documents prepared in accordance with this contract including exhibits, field notes, laboratory data, original drawings, and specifications are the property of the Client. The Consultant is given the right to use any of this data in connection with future engineering projects. The Consultant may retain copies of reproduces of any information prepared for this Project.

5. Fee - The Consultant's fee for the scope of services as stated in Attachment "A" provided by Consultant under this Agreement as set out in Attachment "A".

6. Payment and Fee Schedule - The Consultant will submit a monthly invoice for services rendered.

7. Terms of Payment - Payment of fees as determined under Paragraph 5 herein above shall be due and payable by Client within thirty (30) days following receipt of Consultant's monthly invoice.

8. Additional Services - Additional services beyond those described in the Scope of Services will be invoiced on the basis of direct labor cost times a factor of 2.99 and direct cost plus 10%.

9. Termination - The Client may terminate this contract at any time by giving notice in writing to the Consultant. In that case, all finished or unfinished documents and other materials produced under this contract, shall become the Client's property. If the contract is terminated by the Client in accordance with this provision, Consultant shall be paid for all work performed to the date of termination.
